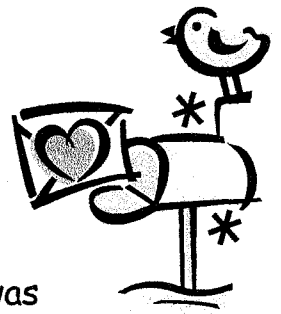


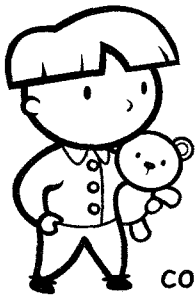
## February News
